A Walk Through the New Fellowship Hall - Today!

- Do not open windows, climb on anything (window sills, ladder going up to the attic, etc.), tamper with any pipes, turn any switches or valves, put hands into wall openings, write on anything, etc.

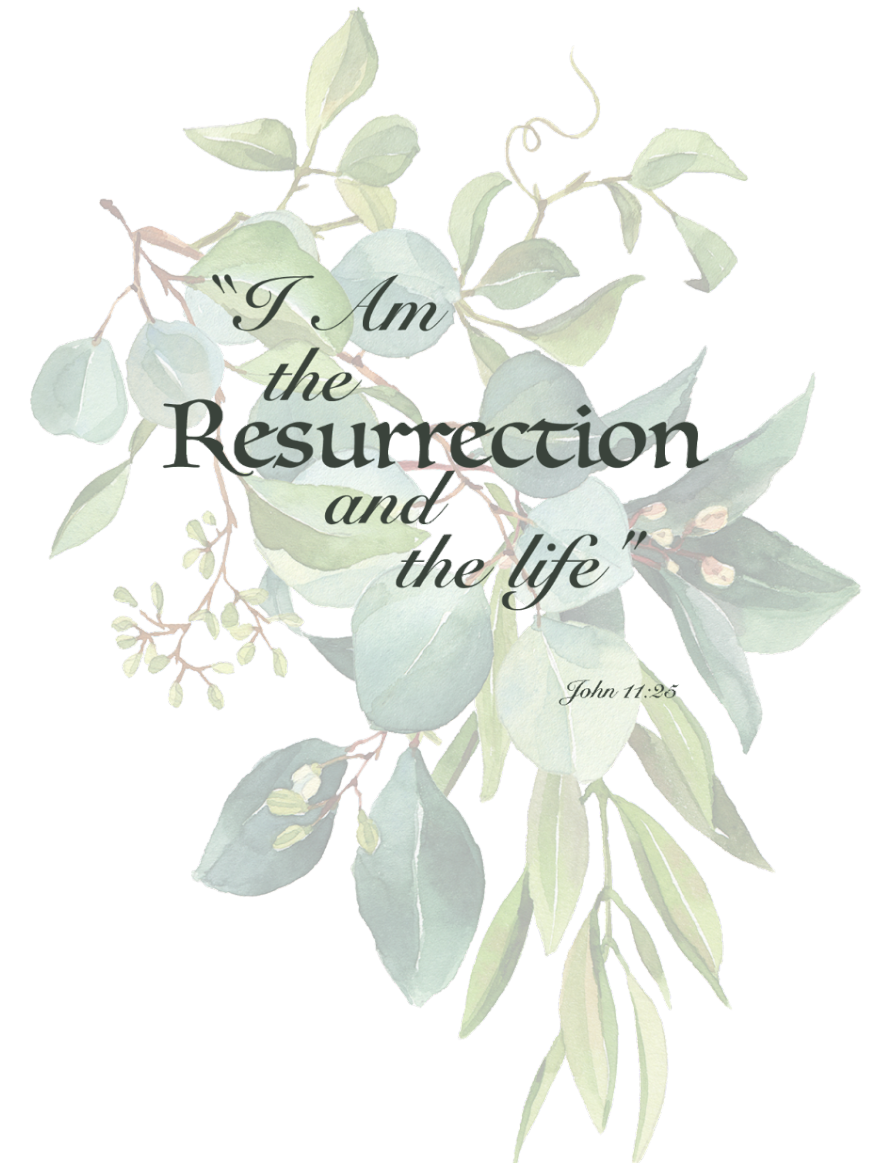
